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RE: Special Quota for Republic of Moldova

Dear Mr. CHETRUSCA,

I would like to inform you that, due to the lack of unanimity within the Road Transport Group, the Special Quota for the Republic of Moldova will unfortunately not be renewed for the year 2025.

As you may be aware, the initial decision to allocate a special quota for the Republic of Moldova was made in 2022, with the understanding that it would be reviewed and renewed on an annual basis for a maximum of three years. For the year 2024, all member countries unanimously agreed to the renewal of the special quota. In 2024, despite our collective efforts, we were unable to reach a unanimous agreement.

However, I understand that the non-renewal of the special quota for 2025 will have an impact on the hauliers, and I truly empathize with the challenges this may present. Please rest assured that should a unanimous agreement be reached within the Road Transport Group during 2025, the ITF Secretariat would be in a position to reconsider and potentially deliver the foreseen for 2025 special quota for the Republic of Moldova.
